A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Alma, Nebraska was held at City Hall on Monday, May 6, 2024, at 5:30 p.m.

Present were Council Members: Tom Moulton, Dyann Collins, Chris Tripe, Larry Casper, and Mayor and Acting Administrator Hal Haeker. Absent: None. City Clerk Dawn McNulty, Treasurer Tashia Butterfield, City Attorney Doug Walker, City Superintendent Russell Pfeil, and City Maintenance man Kent Fleischmann were also in attendance. Notification of this meeting and the agenda was given in advance by posting, a designated method for giving notice. Advance notice of the meeting and the agenda was given to the Mayor and all members of the City Council. All proceedings hereinafter were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Haeker advised the public of the Open Meetings Act posted on the east wall of the meeting room, and then proceeded to call the regular meeting of May 6, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. and the following business was transacted:

Motion by Casper, second by Collins to determine this meeting as previously publicized, duly convened and in open session. Mayor Haeker opened the floor to approve the minutes of the April 17, 2024, council meeting. Motion by Moulton second by Collins, to approve the regular minutes of the April 17, 2024, council meeting. Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss the claims and invoices for April 18, 2024, through May 6, for \$81,676.33. Motion made by Tripe, second by Casper, to approve the claims. Steve Dunnerman said that his was for his own home use, he was not selling power to other homes, and that he anticipated that this would cut his home electrical costs by 50%. Dunnerman stated that this will not be seen from the road but may be visible from the walking path. Schneurle stated the first bid was from John Nelson for \$35,000, the second was from Steve Poole for \$40,000 and the final bid was from Brooke Langley for a photography studio for \$45,000. Nelson and Poole both had contingencies on more parking spaces to the East of the building which is owned by LNRD and the City has no control over. Motion made by Tripe second by

Moulton to approve the bid of \$45,000 from Brooke Langley for 32 N John street. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Tripe, Collins, Moulton, and Casper. Voting no: None. Motion carried.

There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Tripe, Collins, Moulton, and Casper. Voting no: None. Motion carried.
