A regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Alma, Nebraska was held at City Hall on Monday, August 19, 2024, at 5:30 p.m.

Present were Council Members: Tom Moulton, Chris Tripe, Larry Casper, and Mayor and Acting Administrator Hal Haeker. Absent: Dyann Collins. City Clerk Dawn McNulty, Treasurer Tashia Butterfield, City Attorney Doug Walker, and City Superintendent Russell Pfeil were also in attendance. Notification of this meeting and the agenda was given in advance by posting, a designated method for giving notice. Advance notice of the meeting and the agenda was given to the Mayor and all members of the City Council. All proceedings hereinafter were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Mayor Haeker advised the public of the Open Meetings Act posted on the east wall of the meeting room, and then proceeded to call the regular meeting of August 19, 2024, at 5:30 p.m. and the following business was transacted:

Roll call: Tom Moulton-present, Dyann Collins-Absent, Chris Tripe-present, Larry Casper-present, and Mayor Haeker-present. Motion by Casper, second by Moulton to determine this meeting as previously publicized, duly convened and in open session. Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss Swimming Pool wages, hours, and chairs. Treasurer Tashia Butterfield presented a breakdown of current and proposed wages for the swimming pool staff. Butterfield stated that there would be 2 co-managers instead of a manager and assistant manager. There would be an increase for first year lifeguard to \$10.00- and second-year lifeguards to \$12.50 as well with a 25 cent increase each year after that. Butterfield stated that with the increase in wages, we should expect an increase in the budget of \$9,027.00. There were no changes made to the swim team coaches' wages. Butterfield said fees for the pool were proposed at the rates of Family pass to \$120.00 individual \$75.00 and daily to \$4.00. Motion by Casper, second by Moulton to increase wages for the Swimming Pool staff. There being no further discussion upon the motion made and upon roll call vote, the following voted yes: Casper, Moulton and Haeker. Voting no: Tripe. Motion carried. Swimming pool hours and chairs discussion were postponed.

Mayor Haeker opened the floor to discuss and or approve Two Rivers Health Department Presentation. Mayor Haeker notified the council that Two Rivers Health Department would not be here this evening and had requested to come at a later date.

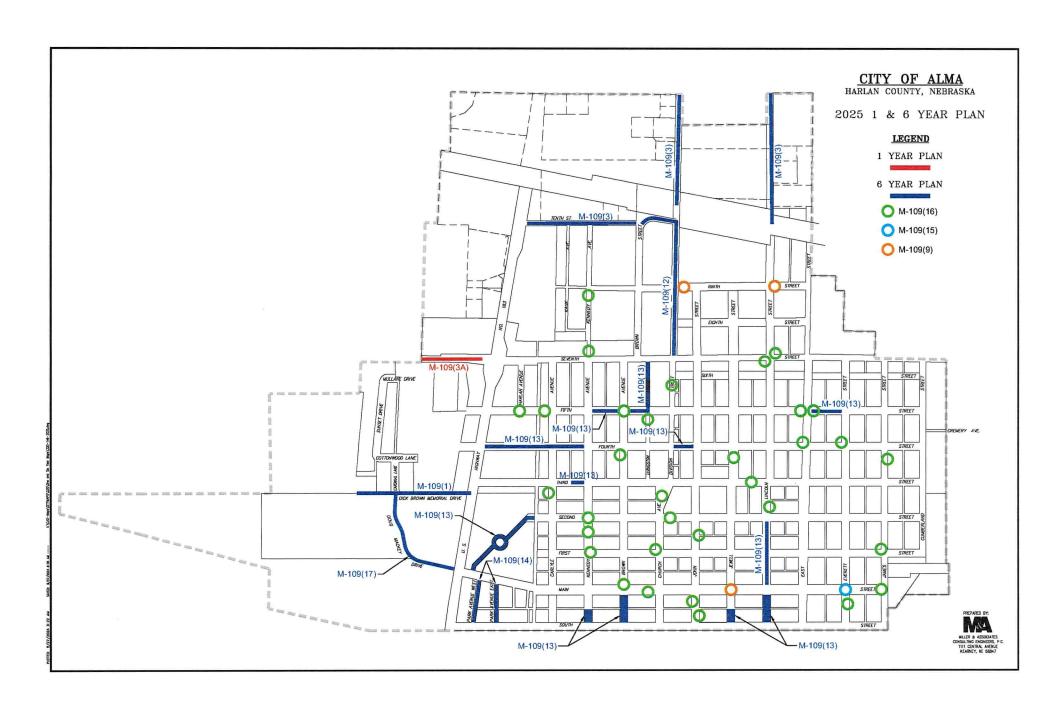
- 1. The 2024-2025 General Fund property tax request be set at \$257,150.04 and the 2024-2025 Bond Fund property tax request be set at \$79,790.00.
- 2. The total assessed value of the property differs from last year's total assessed value by 17.80%.
- 3. The tax rate, which would levy the same amount of property taxes as last year, when multiplied by the new total assessed value of property, would be \$0.300424 per \$100.00 of assessed value.
- 4. The City of Alma proposes to adopt a property tax request that will cause its tax rate to be \$0.304119 per \$100.00 of assessed value.
- 5. Based on the proposed property tax request and changes in other revenue, the total operating budget of the City of Alma will increase from last year's budget by 41.79%.
- 6. That a copy of this Resolution be certified and forwarded to the County Clerk on or before October 15, 2024.
- 7. That the Mayor of the City of Alma is hereby authorized to sign said Property Tax Request on behalf of the City of Alma.

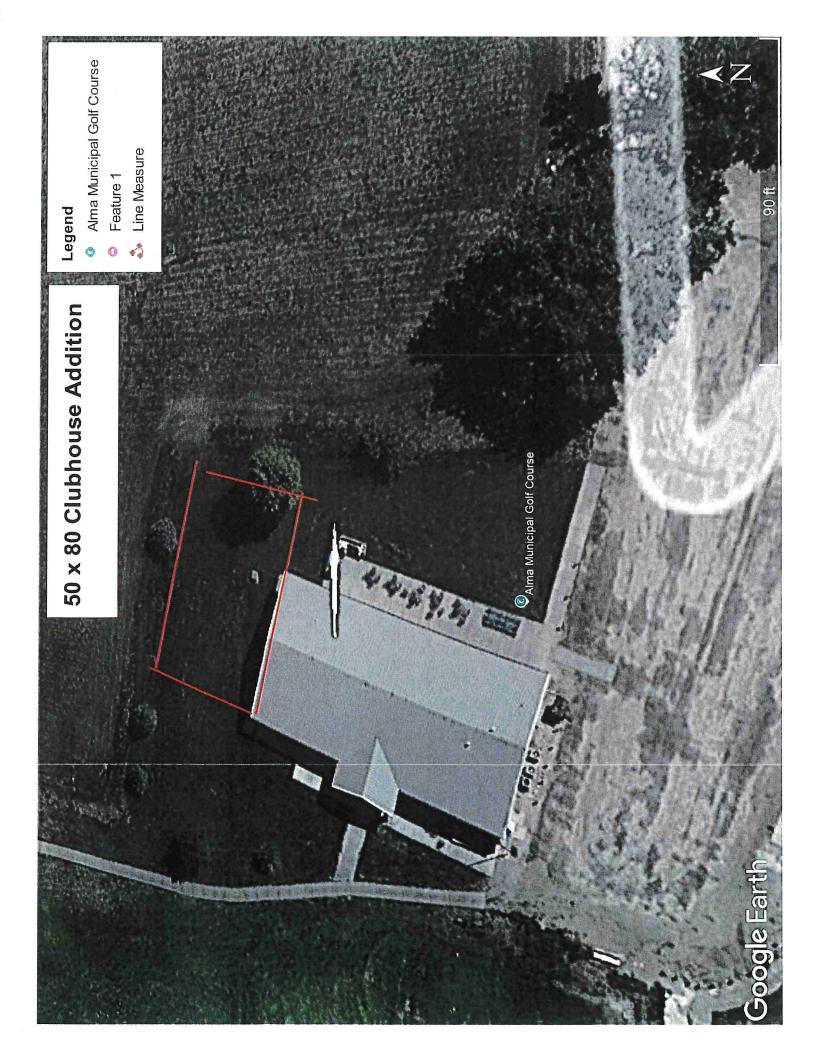

#### WHAT IS TIF ("Tax-Increment Financing")?

Th basic idea: a public-private partnership. To start, a developer must apply to the City to be considered for Tax-Increment Financing. In that process, the developer must prove that (1) the area has defects, substandard housing, or is otherwise considered "blighted", (2) the redevelopment project is consistent with the City's greater future development plans, AND (3) "but-for" TIF, the project would not be feasible. If TIF is approved, the developer must complete their redevelopment project according to the plan provided. As a result, the property values will go up, making the property taxes on the redevelopment project site higher. The County Assessor/Treasurer will break the new tax income into two streams for the duration of the approved TIF (in our case(s), not to exceed 15 years).

The first stream, tied to the old property value before redevelopment—the so-called "base value"—will continue to go where it always went: schools, roads, parks, fire, sanitation, police etc. The second stream shall be all of the *increase* in property taxes tied to the improvement/redevelopment—the so-called "tax increment". It will not go to public services. Instead, it will be diverted back to the developer to subsidize the project's TIF-eligible costs.

#### TIF-Eligible costs include:

- Total amount of <u>public improvements</u> associated with a redevelopment project or adjacent thereto;
- Acquisition of a redevelopment project site;
- Site preparation, demolition, grading, environmental reports for the redevelopment project site;
- Utility extensions within, about, or adjacent to the redevelopment project site;
- Public parking structures;
- Traffic studies, market studies, appraisals, and professional fees associated with the redevelopment project and/or TIF application;

#### TIF-Eligible costs MAY include:

- Well-documented enhancements or rehabilitations to existing structures within the redevelopment project which exceed minimum building codes and urban ACI design standards; and
- Façade improvements to existing structures in a redevelopment project site which also lie in historic or otherwise significant business districts.

#### PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS DEFINED

Public improvements are defined as those capital investments made to serve a municipality or its general public (inhabitants and/or visitors alike) with streets, curb and gutters, sidewalks, storm drainage facilities, street name signs, traffic control devices such as signs, signals, and lane striping, water distribution systems, wastewater collection systems, electrical distribution systems, and street lighting. Other improvements may be considered public improvements if they effect to be caused improved traffic, ways for public transportation, or the expansion of recreational and community facilities.
